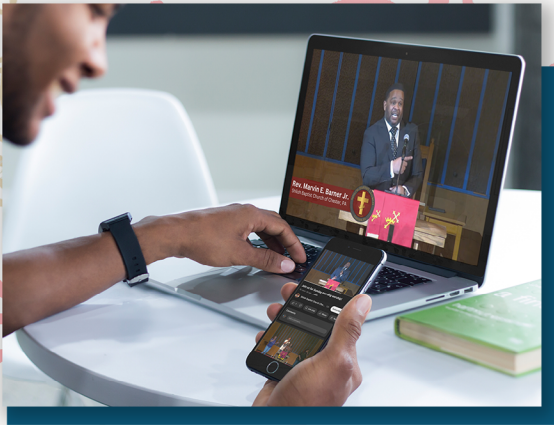

How could a master love a dog that had so many bad qualities? The reason why is because though the dog had many bad qualities it also had some good qualities.

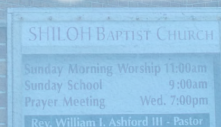

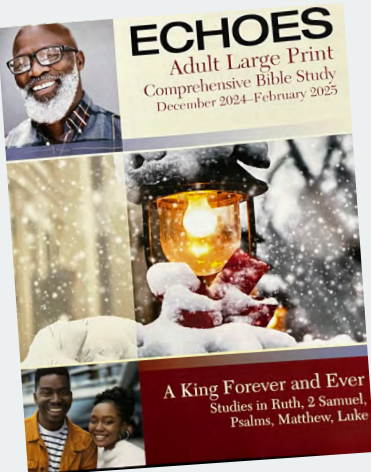
